



## CHÂTEAU COUDERT-MAUVEZIN




**Grapes:** Merlot Noir  
**Vineyard:** 10 hectares

**AOC :** Bordeaux Supérieur  
**Color :** Red  
**Annual production :** 65 000 bottles (75cl)  
**Town :** Vérac  
**Geology :** Clay-Limestone  
**Size :** Double Guyot  
**Harvest :** Mechanical

**Vinification and Ageing:** Fermentation with native yeasts, vinification with low sulphite content, aging in stainless steel and cement vats, light filtration

**Specificities:** Château Coudert-Mauvezin is the origin of the Coudert vineyards. The first vines were planted in 1865 by Jean Baudou. Today the 5th generation of the Family runs this hilly 10 hectares estate planted exclusively with Merlot.

### Tasting:

-  : Intense red
-  : Typical fruitiness of Merlot with notes of plums, chocolate and blackcurrant
-  : Tasty, melted tannins

**Food / Wine pairing:** Cheese platter, grilled meats or chocolate desserts
