Grapes: 90% Merlot Noir, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon

Vineyard : 12 hectares

AOC: Bordeaux

Color : Red

Annual production : 40 000 bottles (75cl)

Geology : Clay-Limestone




Size : Double Guyot

Harvest : Mechanical

Vinification and Ageing : Fermentation with native yeasts, low-sulfite vinification, aged in stainless steel and cement vats, light filtration.

Specificities : Château Cleyrac dominates the Villegouge plateau by 12 hectares in one piece. For more than 15 years, the Coudert family has managed the estate mainly planted with Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon.

-  : Velvety tannins, good length
