**Grapes** : Merlot Noir  
**Vineyard** : 3 hectares

**AOC** : Fronsac  
**Color** : Red  
**Annual production** : 25 000 bottles (75cl)  
**Town** : Saint-Aignan  
**Geology** : Clay-Limestone  
**Size** : Double Guyot  
**Harvest** : Mechanical

**Vinification and Ageing** : Fermentation with native yeast, low-sulfite vinification, aged in oak barrels for 12 months, light filtration

**Specificities** : From a beautiful little vineyard of 3 hectares, we produce this exceptional wine out of the oldest vines of the Coudert property. It is aged in oak barrels renewed by third.

### Tasting:

-  : Garnet red
-  : Powerful and intense with notes of pulpy blackcurrant, blackberry and slightly pepper
-  : Fruity and balanced offering a juicy and mineral structure, full-bodied with a fine freshness

**Food pairing** : Roast veal in a crust, soy marinated skewers
